Christian Service Learning

Serving others is an integral aspect of life at Servite College. All families teach their children that they are to help each other and the family and contribute to their community. At Servite College, we aim to foster the concept of service to others through a Christian Service Learning Programme. Students will receive more information about this next year.

NAS (Northern Associated Schools)

During Term One and Two, Servite College participates in NAS. The aim of NAS is to conduct inter-school sport which encourages participation, sportsmanship and healthy competition. Sports vary depending on the year group, season and gender. Students are transported to their away games and are usually returned to Servite by 5.30pm. Students have the opportunity to nominate for a team at the start of Terms One and Two. Teams are selected at the beginning of the season by the staff member coaching the team. Students will participate in games on different days of the week depending on their year group, as follows:

- Year 7 - Monday
- Year 8 and 9 - Tuesday
- Year 10, 11 and 12 - Wednesday

Music Programme

Servite College offers a music programme whereby students study both the theoretical and practical components of music. Instrumental tuition is also offered for a selected range of instruments.
