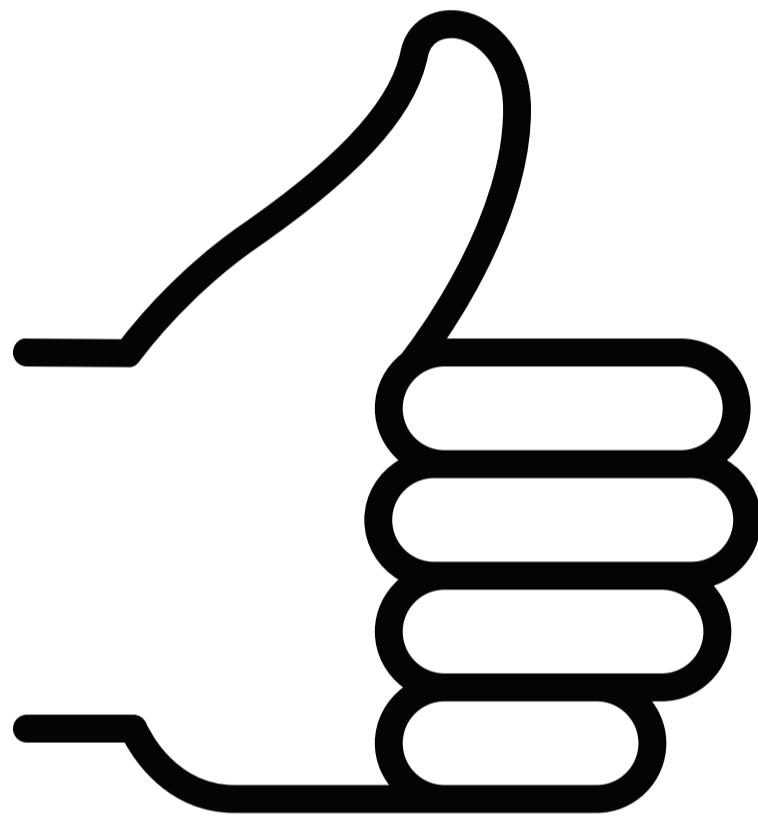

SAFE

To feel this way, we will:

- Create a comfortable and safe environment
- Build strong and friendly relationships
- Build these relationships through teachers and friends

When someone isn't feeling this way, we will:

- Ensure Student Councillors are available and easy to approach
- Have College Counsellors to whom we can express our concerns
- Have peers ready to listen
- Use Servite Concern when needed
- Build our trust in our teachers

MOTIVATED

To feel this way, we will:

- Create a positive and relaxed environment to prepare for the day
- Write down our short-term and long-term goals at the start of each school Term
- Recognise student efforts with certificates and commendations

When someone isn't feeling this way, we will:

- Talk to trusted people about feeling negative or unmotivated
- Be reminded of our short-term goals
- Access videos of past students talking about handling stress

EMPOWERED

To feel this way, we will:

- Use verbal praise and give physical rewards
- Acknowledge others and their opinions/ideas
- Provide resources to succeed
- Create a happy, positive environment
- Enable students to be independent and make decisions
- Don't judge others, but encourage them to be themselves
- Encourage active participation in College activities
- Represent the College well in the community

When someone isn't feeling this way, we will:

- Encourage them to pursue empowering activities
- Praise and reward their achievements
- Remind them of the many avenues of support at the College
- Ensure their ideas and opinions are being heard and acknowledged

ACCEPTED

To feel this way, we will:

- Ensure that we see the gifts of others
- Ensure that all students are included
- Interact with all sections of the community
- Encourage and commend others for their achievement
- Support people in their efforts
- Treat others fairly and justly

When someone isn't feeling this way, we will:

- Identify the signals of loneliness, exclusion and isolation
- Listen and understand the situation
- Act by reaching out and offering support
- Use the support systems that are in place at the College

RESPECTED

To feel this way, we will:

- Refrain from judgement and prejudice of others
- Promote a positive attitude in the College
- Be accepting of others' opinions without stereotyping
- Reduce the sense of social status that often exists
- Be open to various cultures, religions and nationalities
- Treat others with courtesy and kindness

- Establish activities to allow people to communicate more
- Try to break down barriers
